RNP speaks at White House to present innovative new jail diversion program

Recovery Network of Programs' Chief Executive Officer John Hamilton, Chief Clinical Officer Jennifer Kolakowski, and Director of Court Relations Rhonda Panda had the privilege of recently speaking at the Executive Office of the President of National Drug Control Policy to discuss RNP'sTreatment Pathway Program (John Hamilton, pictured in attached photograph). This innovative, uniquely designed pre-

booking program aims to divert non-violent offenders living with substance use disorders into treatment, and has earned national attention for being an effective and lasting alternative to incarceration for drug-related crimes.

"Although this program was just started on April 1, we are seeing a significant impact in reducing the number of individuals who would remain incarcerated in a prison system that is faced with overcrowding and rising costs," stated Mr. Hamilton.

Adds Kolakowski, "By addressing the root causes of criminal behavior, we are now able to provide alternatives to incarceration in an effort to reduce the number of individuals incarcerated due to their substance dependence issues, the majority of whom are better served by substance use and mental health treatment."

John Hamilton making a difference in Vietnam

John Hamilton was chosen by an international human rights group to travel to Vietnam and present his U.S. Model of Care for individuals struggling with opiate addiction.

In December 2014, and again in March 2015, Mr. Hamilton traveled to Vietnam to present an alternative solution to the detention-style camps for opiate-addicted individuals that had caught the attention of several human rights groups. Based on RNP's continuum of care, Mr. Hamilton presented his "U.S. Model of Care" to Vietnam's Ministry of Social Evil Prevention. Implementation of this voluntary addiction treatment program began immediately. Stated Hamilton, "I was honored to be chosen to travel to Vietnam and present a model of care based on RNP's diverse and innovative programs and services and make a difference in the lives of people on the other side of the world."


